Now that our Club Championships have been & gone, it's time to look toward all the Christmas Ham Tournaments around the Bay, & Closing Day/Prizegiving on November 3rd.

We have the Waikohu Christmas Tournament on November 23rd, which is our tautoko for the challenge we have just played. If you haven't been before, try & make the trip as I have been told it is definitely worth it.

The call has gone out for anyone interested in representing Opotiki Golf Club in Pennant teams for 2025. If you are interested, please let your Club Captains know.

Course Highlights...

October is a busy time for course staff, with systems resetting from winter to summer conditions. Irrigation checks & greens management programmes are ramped up in preparation for higher growth but also our mid-summer heat stress period. As many will have noticed the course dries out quite quickly towards the end of October, & this always brings challenges. Greens recovery has been slow from their September renovation, but from now on members should experience improved putting, with lower mowing height & our new roller in operation, stimp-meter readings for ball roll should be better.

Re-modelling the No 6 green is progressing, we are nearly there & about to finalise part 3 of what's been a challenging project. The best laid out plans, of course, not helped by some untimely weather events. Final pieces of work to undertake are re-laying the irrigation to the green, top soiling & hydro seeding. All going well this should be completed over the next two weeks. I'm reluctant to give an opening date but optimistic for New Year. We are also developing plans to better handle the wet conditions in this area for next winter, especially cart access. In the meantime, thanks to members for putting up with the surrogate No 6.

Other work in progress includes, improving & streamlining our machinery servicing, checking irrigation performance & sprinkler alignment, continuing to keep the course presentable & pick up when able some of the nice to do things. Improving our tees is still very much to the forefront but this requires automated irrigation to all the tees.

As you know the boys are getting on in years, with that slowing up, so if anyone thinks they would like to contribute on a regular basis, please let us know. I've outlined previously the help from Hori & Spike on the Donga, & thanks to the crew for their continuing effort across the course.
