Firstly, I would like to say well done to Polly, you are doing an amazing job running the twilight golf every Tuesday night. This is being well supported by our members so let's make sure it continues.

It was great to see such a good turnout for Club closing day on the 3rd November.

It is very pleasing to see the amount of nominations we have for next year's committee. The AGM is Wednesday 20th November at 6.30pm. I look forward to seeing lots of members present.

Course Highlights

As happens every year about this time the course dries out, and while more run will be expected on the fairways, it does mean we will start to see more stress on grass growth (fairways and tees especially) and on high traffic areas. Members will have noted the treated fairways for broadleaf and the dreaded Onehunga (prickle) weed. This has resulted in some loss of grass colour, but if we get a bit of rain in the next couple of weeks they will green up. Duck droppings are causing considerable damage to the greens, so if anybody has a bright idea to reduce please let us know.

At long last, some of the final pieces of work for the re-modelling of No 6 green have taken place. With a new irrigation line installed, surface prep with sand, topsoil and hydro-seeding the surrounds with Browntop were completed during the week. The extra input for this project has put pressure on getting other work around the course completed. A post New Year opening is still on schedule but unfortunately the green will not be ready for the Hams Tournament. Further work has been done on the tees out of action (6, 16 and practice), but again may be a little way off for the Hams.
