## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**





Depreciation

The Committee has reviewed our financial position and is about to start the process of developing the next 5 year strategy. The Committee would like to engage with the membership and work on a plan in working towards how we can sustain our low membership fees.

The pie graph is a breakdown of the clubs expenses with the inclusion of a paid Greenkeeper. As you can see by incorporating a paid greenkeeper role, there is a shortfall of \$663.53 per member. Please also note this does not include donations or work-in-kind donations relating to maintaining or developing our greens – it is a labour only cost.
